OGME-1R, Residency

This is the first year of residency training in specialties where the OGME-1 year is incorporated into the residency (option 1). Educational content is set by the respective specialty colleges as approved by AOA and is supervised by the institutional residency program director.

OGME-1P, Preliminary Internship

This is the first year of training preliminary to residency training in specialties requiring a preliminary tracked internship year (option 2). Educational content is set by the respective specialty colleges as approved by AOA. OGME-1P trainees are supervised by the institutional intern program director. This is an internship year.

OGME-1T, Traditional Internship

This is the first year of training preceding residency training in specialties requiring a traditional internship (option 3), or unrelated to a residency for trainees who have not yet decided on a specialty and/or who want the option of a traditional internship year. This is an internship year.
